What Does the 4th Commandment Mean?

- Option 1: Observe the Sabbath on the <u>Seventh</u> Day
- Option 2: Observe the Sabbath on the <u>First</u> Day
- Option 3: Participate in Worship on the Lord's Day
- Option 4: Treat the Sabbath or Lord's Day Like a Normal Day

While resting in Christ, we wisely embrace God's rhythm of work and rest.

Why Does the 4th Commandment Matter?

- It reminds us to take **God** seriously. . .
 - We must worship the working God with our **work**.
 - We must worship the resting God with our <u>rest</u>.
- It reminds us to take <u>life</u> seriously. . .
 - We need spiritual restoration.
 - We need <u>physical</u> restoration.

How Can We Keep the 4th Commandment?

• By working at worshiping Jesus.

• By **trusting** Jesus enough to rest from our work.

By <u>striving</u> to enter the rest Jesus provides.
