Introduction

Main Idea: Friendship with the world causes conflict with others, within ourselves, and ultimately with God, but His grace enables genuine repentance and restoration for the humble.

- I. Friendship with the World (vv. 1-5)
- Summary: Friendship with the world is the root cause of a selfcentered and selfish lifestyle that bears the rotten fruit of relational conflict.

 - A Few Observations:

 - Although humans are responsible for their wicked actions, there is a demonic element underlying (or sometimes explicitly present in) all human rebellion
